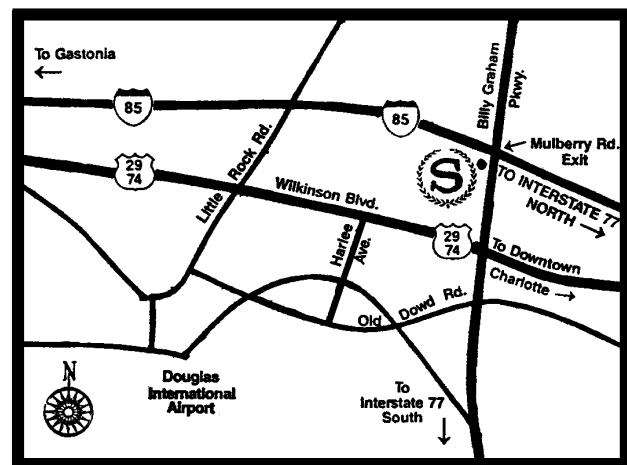

THE LINEUP

CALVIN BEAMON

Calvin is preparing to enter his second season as Assistant Coach at the University of South Carolina. He works with the team's hitters and outfielders. In his first season with the Gamecocks, the team batting average improved 51 points, on-base percentage rose 54 points and slugging percentage gained 92 points. Calvin played for the 2005 National Champions at the University of Texas and played minor league baseball before beginning his career as a private instructor and coach.

PATTY GASSO

Patty is the Head Coach at the University of Oklahoma where she has guided her teams to the Women's College World Series five times, winning it all in 2000. Patty has been named Big 12 Coach of the Year four times, won four Big 12 titles and four Big 12 Tournaments. She has coached 36 All-Americans and 80 All-Region selections. Patty is the winningest coach in Big 12 history and she and her staff have been named Midwest Region Coaching Staff of the Year five times.

LISA NAVAS

Lisa is the first and only Head Coach at North Carolina State. She started the program in 2004 and has won more than 200 games during her tenure. Her team won the Atlantic Coast Conference title and tournament in 2006, earning her ACC Coach of the Year and Southeast Region Coaching Staff of the Year. While Head Coach at Barry University for nine years, Lisa's teams won more than 300 games, two conference titles, and placed 2nd and 5th at the NCAA National Tournament.

EILEEN SCHMIDT

Eileen is heading into her fifth season at the helm of the University of Virginia softball team. In 2010, she guided her team to their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance. In her first four seasons, Eileen has coached five all-ACC selections and four All-Region picks. She returned to her alma mater, where as a player she became the Virginia's first softball All-American. She was a three-time All-ACC catcher, and named ACC Player of the Year in 1993. She has more than 200 career victories.

BETH TORINA

Beth is about to begin her first season as the Head Coach at Louisiana State University. Previously at Florida International where she earned two Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year nods, Beth coached 10 all-conference players in four years. In 2010, Beth's team produced the SBC Pitcher of the Year, Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year. Beth has also served as an assistant coach at the University of Houston and Stetson University. As a player, Beth posted 60 career wins at the University of Florida and guided the 1998 Gators to the SEC championship.
